When It Rains...



- Sewers that work fine the rest of the time become too full
- Can cause overflows of sewage into rivers, and basement back-ups



Traditional **Solution?**



- Just build a bigger sewer
- Only treating the symptom not the cause
- But we have to do something (Consent Decrees with Ohio EPA)
- Current "gray" plan calls for two big, long tunnels, with a big price tag
- \$2 billion over next thirty years

Is There A Better Way?




- Spend money above ground instead of on little-used deep tunnels
- Create opportunity to engage community and rebuild neighborhoods
- Significantly better opportunity for local and small businesses
- Focus on getting the rain water out of the sewer




Blueprint Areas

- To correct SSOs, have about 30,000 acres to address
- Will be adding approximately 10 to 20 acres of green infrastructure per year


Blueprint Job Projections (Regionomics)









