Directions to City of Dayton WRF, 2800 Guthrie Road, Dayton, OH 45417

From North of Dayton: Take I 75 South to Exit 51 – Edwin C. Moses Blvd. Turn right onto Edwin C. Moses Blvd at bottom of exit ramp. Edwin C. Moses Blvd becomes Nicholas Road. Travel approximately 1 mile and turn left on Danner Avenue (just after crossing over RR tracks). Follow Danner Road ½ mile. Danner Rd leads to plant entrance. The Operations Building will be directly across from the entrance of the plant.

From Cincinnati: Take I 75 North to Exit 51 – Edwin C. Moses Blvd. Turn left onto Edwin C. Moses Blvd at bottom of exit ramp. Edwin C. Moses Blvd becomes Nicholas Road. Travel approximately 1 mile and turn left on Danner Avenue (just after crossing over RR tracks). Follow Danner Road ½ mile. Danner Rd leads to plant entrance. The Operations Building will be directly across from the entrance of the plant.

From Columbus: Take I 70 West to Exit 33 to I 75 South. Stay on I-75 South for about 10 miles to Exit 51– Edwin C. Moses Blvd. Turn right onto Edwin C. Moses Blvd at bottom of exit ramp. Edwin C. Moses Blvd becomes Nicholas Road. Travel approximately 1 mile and turn left on Danner Avenue (just after crossing over RR tracks). Follow Danner Road ½ mile. Danner Rd leads to plant entrance. The Operations Building will be directly across from the entrance of the plant.
