Make sure you bring you Core ID Number with you for your Contact Hours!



Dress Code

The following policy **MUST** be complied with everyone participating in a tour within the MillerCoors, Trenton Plant.

- Tours consist of a brisk walking pace. The participant must have the ability to bend and walk under conveyors as well as in wet areas and in areas that have limited movement space.
- Hard Hat, Hearing Protection, Steeled Toe Shoe Overlays, Safety Vests and Safety Glasses **MUST** be worn at all times. Normal eyeglasses do not replace the need for Safety Glasses.
- Shoes **MUST** have enclosed toes and heels. No sandals or slip on shoes of any type may be worn. No high heels may be worn. Shoes of a leather or durable material are preferred.
- Full length pants **MUST** be worn. Tours consist of climbing stairs and elevated walk ways. No skirts or shorts are permitted.
- Long hair must be pulled back and secured.
- Shirts **MUST** have sleeves. No tank tops or midriff bearing clothing items are permitted. No loose or baggy jackets.
- No jewelry may be worn.
- No purses or duffle bags may be carried during a tour.
- No cameras or camera phones may be taken on a tour unless special permission is received from our Corporate offices prior to the scheduled tour.
