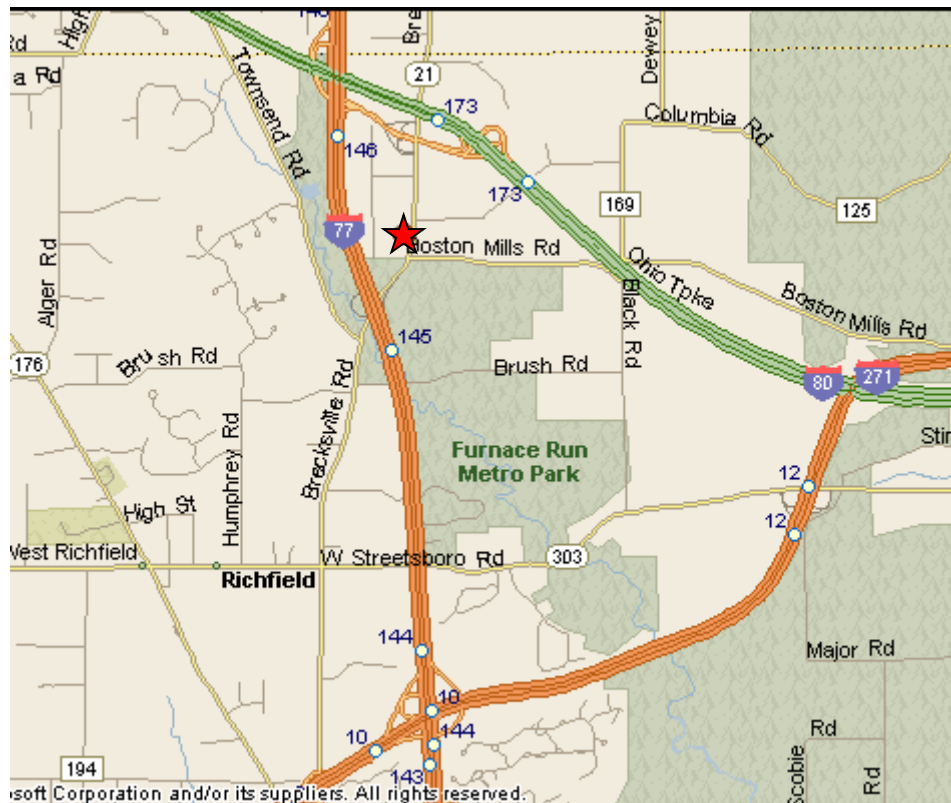
Cancellations must be received 3 days prior to meeting in order not to be charged for meeting.
