The Rocky River WWTP is located at 22303 Lake Road, Rocky River, Ohio. This regional wastewater treatment plant is owned by the cities of Bay Village, Fairview Park, Rocky River and Westlake. It is operated by the City of Rocky River. Sanitary sewage from all four cities is treated at the plant. The plant was designed for 22.5 MG average daily flow and 45 MG peak secondary treatment flow. Treatment processes include primary clarification, fixed film reactors and anaerobic digestion. The plant presses Class B Biosolids for land application and landfill.

The plant was originally constructed in 1937. It was completely replaced in 1962 to include an increase in capacity and biosolids processing. Secondary treatment was added in 1982. Major improvements over the years have included wet weather increased capacity, headworks improvements and upgrades, electrical upgrades, and complete plant SCADA integration.

From east/west on I-480, or east on I-90, exit onto Clague Rd. Follow Clague Rd north to Lake Rd (US 6), turn right and travel ~0.8mi to WWTP. Entrance to WWTP is on the right. **From WWTP to Memorial Hall**: Exit WWTP drive by turning right onto Lake Rd (US 6) and travel 0.8mi to Wager Rd. Turn right onto Wager Rd and travel south ~0.9mi.
