To Brushwood Pavilion: From I-77 (northbound or southbound) take Exit 146, or from Ohio Turnpike (I-80, eastbound or westbound) take Exit 173, to Brecksville Road (SR 21). Turn off either exit ramp onto Brecksville Road (SR 21) and travel south ~1.0 mile to Townsend Road. Turn right onto Townsend Road and travel ~1.0 mile north to the Brushwood Pavilion park entrance (on right). Look for meeting signs.
