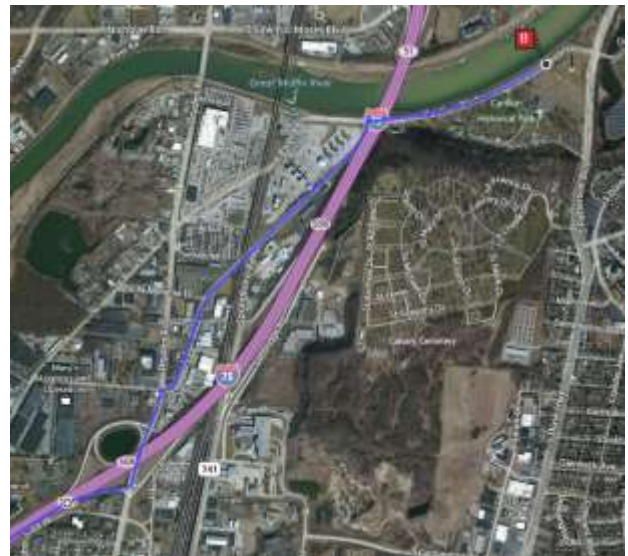
Directions to Carillon Park:
