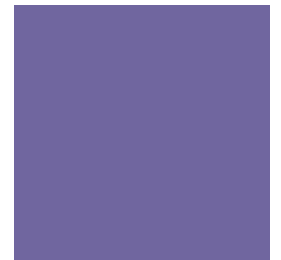




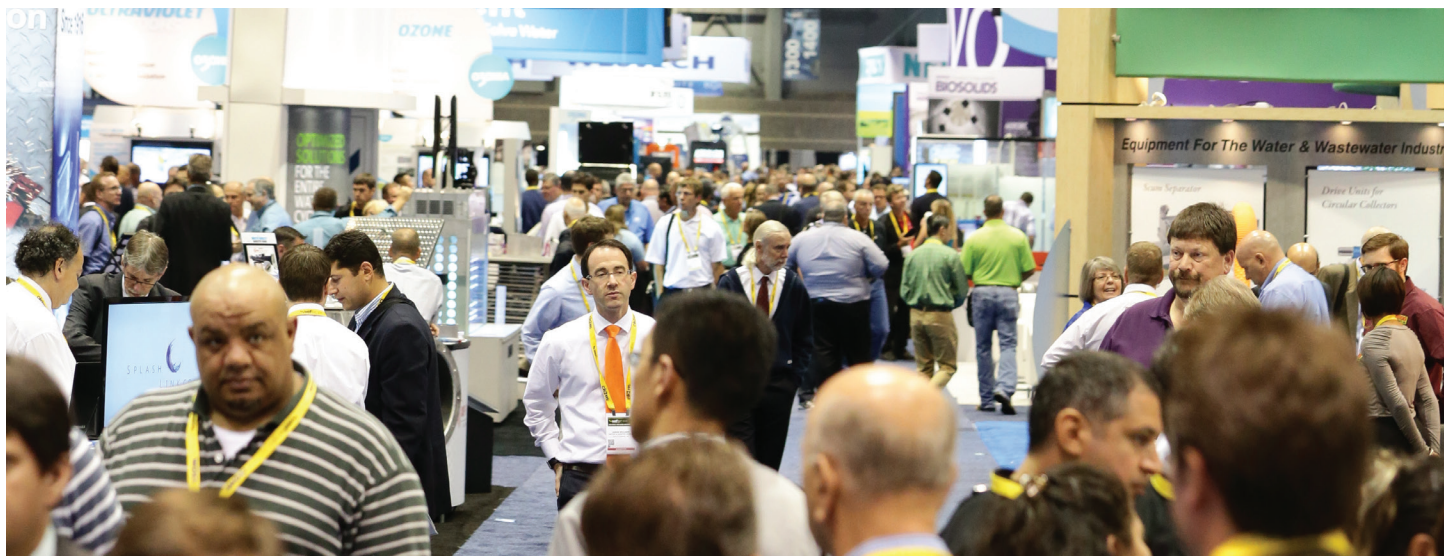

### **Step 1**

### **Step 2**

WEF will provide a list of current and former members within your utility, allowing you to specify which members will be designated in your Utility Partnership Program.

### **Step 3**

You determine when you want your UPP cycle to begin. WEF staff will synchronize renewal dates and pro-rate any necessary dues amounts.

### **Step 4**

WEF will consolidate all current and new memberships into your new annual invoice.
