City of Painesville Water Pollution Control Thursday, September 22, 2022

Painesville's Water Pollution Control facility is an activated sludge, biological treatment plant that is designed to treat an average daily flow of 6.0 MGD and a peak hydraulic flow of 28 MGD. The plant was originally built as a primary treatment plant and upgraded on several occasions, with the last major upgrade occurring in 2009. The treatment processes include typical units such as preliminary, primary, secondary and disinfection systems. Treatment highlights are tertiary treatment (gravity mixed media filters) and chlorine disinfection equipment that generates low strength sodium hypo-
