The City of Lorain is hosting the Northeast Section OWEA Young Professionals group to tour their PQM WWTP. The PQM WWTP was constructed from 1986 to 1988. The PQM WWTP was constructed on the West side of Lorain instead of attempting to transport all future flow to the Black River WWTP. PQM was originally designed and is still operating as a Trickling Filter Wastewater Treatment Plant. PQM has a daily average of 2.6 MGD, PQM was designed with a Design Capacity of 5.4 MGD and a Maximum Hydraulic Capacity of 14.8 MGD. PQM is equipped with a 6mm bar screen, aerated grit system, 4 Primary Settling Tanks, 3 random media Tricking Filters, a phosphorus precipitation tank, 3 Final Settling Tanks, and a Chlorine Contact Tank.
