# City of Elyria Wastewater Pollution Control Thursday, September 19, 2024

In operation since 1929, the City of Elyria's Wastewater Pollution Control Plant was one of the first facilities in Ohio to provide secondary treatment utilizing the suspended growth activated sludge process. Effluent from the plant is discharged to the Black River approximately eight miles upstream of Lake Erie.

On a typical day, the Elyria Wastewater Plant treats approximately 6 MGD and can treat up to 30 MGD.
