We invite you to join us for a facility tour of Youngstown Wastewater Treatment Plant (YWWTP), annual business meeting and awards, and technical sessions in Youngstown, Ohio!

The City of Youngstown developed a LTCP to control CSOs and to abate pollution from their combined sewer system, which included re-establishing the peak treatment capacity of the YWWTP. The tour focus on the four wastewater treatment improvements projects that enabled the City to comply with the LTCP Part 1 mandate of treatment of 80 MGD peak flow. Improvements included: Electrical Upgrades, Secondary Treatment Improvements; Primary Settling Tanks Improvements; UV Disinfection Improvements and Primary Effluent Pumping and Disk Filter Improvements.
